Staff are working together on ensuring the transition between classes is as smooth as possible and they will be well prepared for Wednesday 1st July when they teach their new class for the day. The majority of our Year 6 children will be at their new schools. We will also welcome our new Reception children.

Children must wear a sensible plain black shoe for school all year round. Sandals and open toed shoes are not appropriate. These shoes should be 'polishable' this is inline with our feeder secondary schools.

If you are planning ahead / buying for September -

- Year 6 children wear a special tie provided by school - we will give these to Y5 at the end of term ready.
- Children must wear a sensible plain black shoe for school all year round
- Y1-6 Children must have a school book bag or a suitable backpack. No other bags are appropriate.
- On PE days - the PE Kit and/or tracksuit should be worn. School tracksuit bottoms or shorts should be worn - not leggings, or other tracksuit bottoms.
- Jewelry - only plain stud earrings are allowed, and should not be worn in PE.

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.
